Notes

In the manuscript columns, "e" denotes the end of the chapter, e.g. *37-e* means verses 37 to the end of the chapter.

A range such as 1-13a means from verses 1 to the first part of verse 13. A range such as 13b-e means from the second part of verse 13 to the end.

* John 7:53 - 8:11, the *pericope de adultera*, for internal variational purposes, requires using the manuscripts containing it:

- without note of suspicion: cdefgh*opqrst, also with obelisks klmn, also in margin a**, with peculiarities v (total 18, but hiatus c 7:53-8:2).
- These omit it (not as a hiatus): **a*bxy** (4).
- Hiatus (not omission) **ju** (2).

John 20:19-e: Scrivener's introduction gives \mathbf{x} as having a hiatus here, but his collation quotes \mathbf{x} throughout (6 times in all). Perhaps this is a second hand. We count codex \mathbf{x} as a witness here.

Brackets:

- Round brackets, (...): a second hand complementing *an omission*. This concerns John 7:53-8:11, dealt with above.
- Square brackets, [...]: a second hand complementing *a hiatus*. We count the second hand as an extra witness, **remembering** <u>not</u> to increment the total number of witnesses. (In such cases, Scrivener does not use * and ** notation he uses italics so we are not particularly in danger of inadvertently incrementing the total number of witnesses).
- Angle brackets, (...): a comment that could affect legibility/availability, but we assume the witness is present.
 - \circ codex **g**: where Traheron's witness covers the now missing sheet.
 - o codex o: we take the erased last half page of John as still legible (verses affected not specified).
 - codices **cx**: where torn, but we assume they are legible.

Where there is mention of a first hand (*) and second hand (**) in situ, or where a lectionary has a double but conflicting witness (indicated e.g. by e.g. *ysemel*), we count each as one witness (**remembering to increase the total number of witnesses, except in the bracket cases mentioned above**). We count a double witness of the same reading in the same document as one witness (indicated by Scrivener by e.g. *ybis*).

Codex u: it seems to be based on Bennet's "miserably incompetent" collation of Matthew and Mark only. Options on how to use u in our counting:

- Ignore it completely. This complicates the counting, throws away what could be good evidence.
- Only count explicit mention of it (since the indictment is that its silence is untrustworthy). This would bias against TR, since support for TR would not be counted.
- Treat it like any other manuscript. This could bias towards TR, as overlooked deviations from TR would be counted as supporting the TR.
- Be explicit where Scrivener is explicit, 17+u/20

For simplicity, we treat it like any other manuscript, and refer our reader to Scrivener in cases where the reader would like the detail. Where \mathbf{u} is in a small group of witnesses for the TR, so obtained by elimination of witnesses reading otherwise, we remark that \mathbf{u} is very doubtful.

Codices \mathbf{j} (now part of codex N, Purpureus) and \mathbf{x} (now lectionary l 183) are in uncials.
